WORKS IN THE MUSIC INDUSTRY

Ferenc Muck has performed hundreds of concerts and played on hundreds of records for bands including *LGT*, *Tankcsapda* and *Hungária*. He attended international jazz festivals such as the EBU festival in Strassbourg, Vienna, Graz, Helsinki and Tallinn as the soloist of *Aladár Pege's* band between 1986-'89. He was the member of Rock-Theatre until 1989, the saxophonist of the band *RABB* from 1991 and the leader of his band *Muckshow* from 1995. He also played in *Djabe* between 1997-2000. From 2005 he is the leader of *Muck trio*, and from 2008 the leader of the band *Groupensax*. He was also a constant guest of international festivals between 2012-14 with *Bluesberry Band*. Meanwhile he has been teaching jazz history in high schools.
