

Dear Colleagues,

In view of the current situation regarding the coronavirus disease COVID-19 as well as the resolutions of the Hungarian Government, we would like to inform you about the decision of KJU's Operational Core regarding the modifications to the program of the 10th International Week:

1. Registration and administration of the mobility will be scheduled for Monday, 30 March 2020; however, the opening ceremony and buffet dinner will be cancelled.
2. The classes offered by the applicant faculty will be streamed providing online access to all KJU students via online;
3. The conference papers will be scheduled conform to the original program; however, the large audience plenaries will be cancelled as well as the presentations related the Erasmus+ K2 Touriboost project.
4. The workshops for non-teaching staff participants will be scheduled conform to the original program.
5. The bus excursion scheduled for Friday; 3 April will be cancelled.

The final program of the 10th International Week will be forwarded to all participants in a couple of days as well as it will be uploaded to our website, too.

If your institution or government has introduced restrictions to travelling abroad that prevent you from participation at the International Week at our Budapest Campus, please inform us as soon as possible. Based on the information provided by our National Agency, in case you decide to cancel your participation although you have already made all the travel arrangements in advance, the situation may be considered a force majeure, and on the grounds of an individual request letter and the supporting evidence (air ticket etc.), the occurred expenses will be covered by the sending institution in case of K103 mobility and by KJU in case of K107 (ICM) mobility.

We hope that despite these health precautions, the 10th KJU International Week will be beneficial for both faculty and students.
